MEMBERSHIP AT THE NILE SWIM CLUB

The Nile Swim Club is a member-owned and operated 501c3 non-profit organization. The NSC membership body, is the heart of the Club. Active participation is a requirement of membership at the Nile Swim Club. Annual Membership of the Nile Swim Club runs from May -September, with onsite events occurring in September and October.

Member Guest Passes

- ❖ 2 Guest Passes per day are allowed per membership account. All Guests must be accompanied by a Member.
- ❖ Members who reserve use of the club for a special event are allowed to purchase 60 passes, with additional fees. Only 3 member groups are allowed per day.
- ❖ Guest passes can be purchased online via the member portal.

Membership Profile

You can access your membership profile at www.nileswimclub.org/members-only. It is important to keep your contact information updated on your profile for frequent and effective communication from the Nile Swim Club. Members are encouraged to download the Wild Apricot 'Member' App on their smartphone. The app is available for Android and iPhone.

Club Member ID Cards

Members can access their Membership ID through the Wild Apricot App and download to their phone or, opt to print their ID card by selecting print on the member portal . Please upload a photo to your membership profile of your family dynamic. ID cards must be shown during Club entry. Members may be required to show their club member ID for equipment rentals, ticket purchases and for entry at NSC events.

Entry Policy

Members must show member ID card, upon request and must check in with the Front Desk Staff upon entry.

Member Guests must be signed in with the front desk attendant by the hosting member using no more than 2 of the guests passes purchased.

Becoming a Board Member and or Committee person

Each Governor and Officer shall be an individual at least 21 years of age who must be a financial member of the Nile Swim Club. In electing Governors and Officers, the Members shall consider each candidate's willingness to accept responsibility for governance including availability to take part actively in Board activities, areas of interest and ability, and experience in organizational and community activities. Facilities

Furniture Use

The NSC provides members with a variety of seating options throughout the club. Any NSC furniture should **NOT** be moved to another location by members. If assistance is needed, please contact the front desk if you need assistance in finding proper seating. **ALL** seating in the NSC is on a first come, first served basis. No areas can be reserved unless done so through the NSC Events committee.

Grills

Use of grills for NSC members and guest is available on first come first served basis. There are designated spaces for grilling, at no time should a grill be moved from its location. There will be pails located by the grills for dumping the ashes. If assistance is needed, see the front desk.

Parking

Please park legally; one spot per car, between cones in the rear lot and the lines in the front lot. Pull vehicle fully into the parking space to avoid hindering traffic. Cars parked illegally risk being ticketed and towed at the owner's expense. Gates and walkways should not be blocked at any time.

Swim Attire

The Nile Swim Club is a family friendly environment for visitors of all ages and gender. We ask that members and visitors come dressed in respectful and proper swim attire. No underwear or undergarments are allowed in the pool. Non-swimming visitors must be clothed in swim attire or appropriate clothing.

All members are required to rinse off at the shower prior to entering the pool.

Smoking on Grounds

The Nile Swim Club's pool, lawn space, pavilion, courts and decks are **ALL** smoke free environments.

Alcohol Policy Alcohol is PROHIBITED on NSC grounds. Members and visitors with alcohol on Club grounds are subject to dismissal.

NILE SWIM CLUB CODE OF CONDUCT

ALL MEMBERS, GUESTS AND PATRONS ARE REQUIRED TO ABIDE BY THE RULES OF THE NILE SWIM CLUB.

Remember the NSC strives to provide a safe, fun family environment for ALL.

- ❖ POOL PATRONS MUST ADHERE TO LIFEGUARD COMMANDS
- ❖ NO RUNNING ALLOWED
- ❖ NO HORSEPLAY OR FOUL LANGUAGE WILL BE TOLERATED
- ❖ PROPER SWIM ATTIRE IS REQUIRED TO ENTER POOL (thongs, topless attire is prohibited during regular pool hours)– NO UNDERGARMENTS ALLOWED
- ❖ CHILDREN UNDER 3 YEARS OF AGE OR NOT POTTY-TRAINED MUST WEAR SWIM DIAPER
- ❖ NO GLASS ALLOWED ON FACILITY GROUNDS
- ❖ NO FOOD OR DRINKS ALLOWED IN POOL AREA
- ❖ PERSONS WITH SKIN, EYE OR NASAL INFECTIONS, OPEN CUTS OR WOUNDS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO ENTER THE POOL
- ❖ NO PETS ALLOWED ON GROUNDS
- ❖ CHILDREN UNDER 14 YEARS OF AGE MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT AT ALL TIMES ON FACILITY GROUNDS
- ❖ NO OUTSIDE POOL ACCESSORIES ARE ALLOWED EXCEPT FOR POOL NOODLES & SWIMMERS FOR BABIES AND YOUNG CHILDREN. RESTRICTIONS INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO, DONUTS, LIFESAVERS AND FLOATS
- ❖ NO WATER GUNS OR WATER SPRAYING DEVICES ALLOWED
- ❖ KEEP YOUR AREA CLEAN ALL THROUGHOUT YOUR STAY.
PLEASE PUT ALL TRASH IN TRASH RECEPTACLES
CONVENIENTLY PLACED THROUGHOUT THE PREMISES.
- ❖ **No Smoking - tobacco and non tobacco products are not allowed**
- ❖ No VAPING
- ❖ Drug Free Zone
- ❖ No Weapons Allowed
