INTRODUCTON

ABOUT THE NILE SWIM CLUB

Tucked next to Yeadon's Community Park just off of Union Avenue in Yeadon, sits a neighborhood swim club that has served this area as a special gathering place for over 60 years. The Nile Swim Club offers a swimming pool, basketball court, tennis court, baby pool, covered & uncovered picnic and BBQ areas, and a lovely lawn area where many family-friendly events are hosted throughout the summer. The club is housed on 4.5 acres of land in Yeadon and is located at the corner of Lincoln and Union Avenues. Providence Road and Paul Street surround the Club facility. The front of the property houses the reception area, bathrooms and changing rooms, and the pump room. The pavilion is housed towards the middle of the property, which includes the snack bar and storage areas.

The Nile Swim Club is the first and, today, the only black owned swim club in the country. It is commonly known to members and the community as "the Nile" or "the Club."

HISTORY OF THE NILE SWIM CLUB

The Nile Swim Club (NSC) is a member owned and operated 501c3 non-profit corporation in Yeadon, PA. The Club was established in 1958 when two African American families applied for membership at the racially exclusive Yeadon Swim Club, located in the suburbs of Pennsylvania, and were denied. In response, Yeadon's African American community decided to build its own private swim club that welcomed all races. For 60 years the Nile Swim Club has provided the community with a safe place for families to enjoy the summer. In addition, the club provides swim facilities for day camps in the surrounding area, swim lessons for the community, teen splash parties for the youth, and other activities for community members of all ages.

OUR MISSION STATEMENT

It is the mission of the Nile Swim Club to provide a safe, family friendly pool and picnic facility to the community of Yeadon and beyond. We aim to provide fun and safe all-season activities for people of all ages while preserving the Club's history and the foundation.

MEMBERSHIP AT THE NILE SWIM CLUB

Weekends are reserved for Members Only, but members may purchase and reserve a maximum of 24 Guest Passes for a Reserved Event, scheduled in advance with the NSC Event Coordinator, with a limit of 2 Reserved Events each Saturday and Sunday.

Members are encouraged to download the Wild Apricot 'Member' App on their smartphone. The app is available for Android and iPhone.

Club Member ID Cards

Members can access their Membership ID through the Wild Apricot App or opt to receive a printed ID card. Please upload a photo to your membership profile of your family dynamic. ID cards must be shown during Club entry. Members may be required to show their club member ID for equipment rentals, ticket purchases and for entry at NSC events.

Lost or Damaged Club Member ID Cards

If you receive a printed club member ID card notify the NSC management if you have lost or damaged your card. A \$10 fee will be assessed for each replacement membership card.

More About Membership at the Nile Swim Club

- Children 15 years and younger must be on a membership with an adult 20 years of age or older.
- ➤ Memberships can be purchased year-round with extra benefits for payment during specified times throughout the year.
- Members are encouraged to join a NSC standing committee and are eligible to run for election to the NSC Board of Governors during election season.

- CHILDREN UNDER 3 YEARS OF AGE OR NOT POTTY-TRAINED MUST WEAR SWIM DIAPER
- NO GLASS ALLOWED ON FACILITY GROUNDS
- O NO FOOD OR DRINKS ALLOWED IN POOL AREA
- PERSONS WITH SKIN, EYE OR NASAL INFECTIONS, OPEN CUTS OR WOUNDS
 ARE NOT ALLOWED TO ENTER THE POOL
- NO PETS ALLOWED ON GROUNDS
- CHILDREN UNDER 14 YEARS OF AGE MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT AT ALL TIMES ON FACILITY GROUNDS
- NO OUTSIDE POOL ACCESSORIES ARE ALLOWED EXCEPT FOR POOL
 NOODLES & SWIMMERS FOR BABIES AND YOUNG CHILDREN. RESTRICTIONS
 INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO, DONUTS, LIFESAVERS AND FLOATS
- NO WATER GUNS OR WATER SPRAYING DEVICES ALLOWED
- KEEP YOUR AREA CLEAN ALL THROUGHOUT YOUR STAY.
 PLEASE PUT ALL TRASH IN TRASH RECEPTACLES

Entry Policy

Members must show member ID card, upon request and must check in with the Front Desk Staff upon entry.

Member Guests must be signed in with the front desk attendant by the hosting member using one or more guests passes on their membership. Member guests are only allowed Monday - Friday. (Maximum in 2021 is 2 per day)

Parking

The Nile Swim Club has a small parking lot where members and guests can park for FREE. All cars must be parked legally. Any vehicles parked illegally are subject to tow and/or ticketing.

Swim Attire

The Nile Swim Club is a family friendly environment for visitors of all ages. We ask that members and visitors come dressed in respectful and proper swim attire. No

underwear or undergarments are allowed in the pool. Non-swimming visitors must be clothed in swim attire or appropriate clothing.

Pool Accessories

The Nile Swim Club does not allow the entrance of outside pool accessories including but not limited to donuts, lifesavers and floats. A limited number of pool accessories may be available for purchase/rental at the front desk.

The following pool accessories are allowed at the discretion of safety from NSC lifeguards, Board of Governors and Pool Manager:

- Noodles
- O Swimmers for infants, babies and young children
- ***Please Note: For the 2021 season, per CDC guidelines, pool noodles and swimmers will not be provided. You may bring your own.

Smoking on Grounds

The Nile Swim Club's pool, pavilion, courts and decks are smoke free environments. Smoking is permitted in designated areas where posted.

Alcohol Policy

Yeadon Borough is a dry-town. Alcohol is PROHIBITED on NSC grounds. Members and visitors with alcohol on Club grounds are subject to dismissal.

NILE SWIM CLUB FACILITIES

The facility is open 12:00PM – 8:00PM daily from season opening to season closing. The Club is staffed by a combination of employees, volunteers, lifeguards and board members. NILE SWIM CLUB RENTALS

The Club facilities are available for rental by members only for group events. The Club has been known as a great location to host family reunions, pool parties, employee picnics, club gatherings and more. Members hosting events at the Club are eligible for additional benefits/discounts.

Rain Date Policy

Renters have the option to include a "rain date" in their NSC rental agreement. The chosen "rain date" must be available and approved by the NSC Board of Governors. NSC is not responsible for providing a "rain date" if it is not identified in the original rental agreement.

ADDENDUM

Nile Swim Club Guidelines for Pool Use During COVID-19 Health Emergency Summer 2021 Season

Dear Members,

In order to adhere to the guidelines established by Delaware County and the PA Department of Health for opening pool facilities during the COVID-19 public health crisis, we must strictly follow the rules below, based on and in addition to national, state and local health guidelines, which are enforceable by law enforcement, may result in the loss of pool/membership privileges and ultimately closure of the pool by the Delaware County Department of Health. Please keep these guidelines handy and carefully follow them for the safety of yourself, your family and the community.

- 1. If you are feeling ill or have symptoms of coronavirus, please DO NOT ENTER the Nile Swim Club
- 2. Members and guests are encouraged to bring your own chairs and remove when upon leaving the Nile Swim Club. Please return all NSC chairs to the designated area for cleaning after use.
- 3. Members and guests must shower before entering the pool. You are encouraged to shower at home and wear your suit under your clothes to avoid/minimize use of the common area changing rooms.
- **4.** Members and guests **must sign-in** at the front desk <u>every</u> time you enter the Nile Swim Club
- **5. Wash your hands** after signing in (use soap and water and/or hand sanitizer) before and after visiting the front desk area.
- **6.** Face masks must be worn on NSC grounds when interacting with individuals not in your family unit/household. For safety reasons, DO NOT wear a face mask in the water.
- 7. Read and follow all rules of the Nile Swim Club
- 8. There are no more than 25 people allowed in the pool at any time -- please follow swim session guidelines to maintain use of the pool and maximize the Nile Swim Club experience. Practice social distancing = Keep 6 feet apart from non-members of your family unit/household on NSC grounds and in the water.
- **9.** Social distancing should be practiced in the water with anyone outside of your own household.
- **10.** Use and remove your own water accessories and toys not sharing with people outside of your household.
- 11. Do not share goggles, nose clips or snorkels
- 12. Do not share food, toys with persons outside of your family/household
- 13. Swim sessions are divided into 45 minute sessions to follow PA

 Department of Health requirements limiting pool capacity to 25 people
 at a time. Please follow swim session guidelines to maintain use of the pool
 and maximize the Nile Swim Club experience. Nile Swim Club management
 will monitor facility attendance and extend swim sessions as appropriate.
- **14. Please follow these guidelines** in order to preserve our ability to keep the pool open during this public health emergency.
- **15.** Be advised that guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), federal, state or local authorities may change as the summer progresses.
- **16. THANK YOU FOR YOUR PATIENCE and UNDERSTANDING** and for BEING A PART OF THE NILE SWIM CLUB FAMILY!
